Flow Ventures provides seed funding and hands-on operational services for startup firms at the launch or growth phases of their development. Raymond is a Director of Symtext Corporation and is an advisor for many entrepreneurs and new ventures.

Raymond started his first company, HBE Software, when he was 24 years-old and grew the firm profitably developing leading-edge Web software for government and corporate clients throughout North America. He also founded Opendesk, a venture-backed software-as-a-service company in 2000. In 2005 he was an investor and executive at Aptilon Corporation which completed a public offering on the TSX. Since then he has founded several profitable software companies in addition to Flow Ventures.
